Jill created a fantastic valentine table of goodies and Robin made three pans of fresh homemade blueberry muffins.

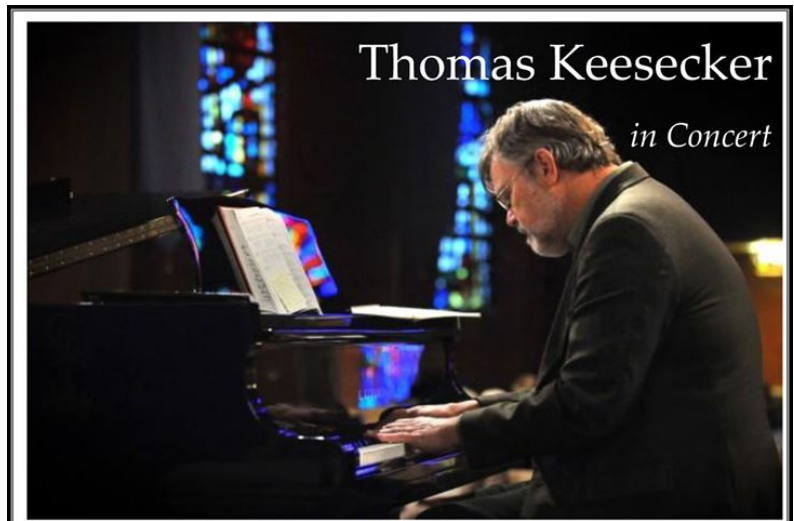
Spotlight on Volunteers!
